Time and again, **Jamie McWilliams** has asked State Attorney **Lawson Lamar** why his office chose not to pursue criminal charges against a 19-year-old who ran over and killed her son.

Finally, Monday, she got a response — from prosecutor **Bill Vose**, who began his e-mail by blaming the *Orlando Sentinel* for some of her heartache, saying his office didn't have time to let the family know about the decision before the paper reported it.

You know, with all the cases that this office chooses *not* to prosecute, there should be plenty of time to personally call victims' families and let them know that.

McWilliams found the e-mail offensive and patronizing. She said Wednesday: "All I want is an answer to what happened to my son."
